He formed The Policy Group in 1999, and works on behalf of the finishing industry on a wide range of topics, including environmental, health and safety, defense, science and technology, trade and energy policy.

Prior to his consulting experience, Mr. Richter served in policy positions in the Wisconsin and Minnesota state legislatures, and advised and represented local governments before state agencies and in two state capitols on health, environmental, economic development, agriculture and manufacturing issues.
