


The tour was quite fascinating and you





In August of 1969 when all the rage was about landing on the moon, both Fred Vosecky and James Bubis were focusing on their new careers. Fred at Abbott-Screw & Mfg in Chicago and Jim at Continental Screw Machine Products in Rosemont.

Fred started out in Sales on Clark Street in Chicago at a time when standards were king in the industry. Selling back then was more about making contact via phone sales and calling customers advising them of what specials there were that week. It was not unusual to send out faxes with "lists"

of parts we needed to move based on what we had in inventory and not necessarily what customers requested. Fred became the company expert for locknut Sales to Distributors, a role he still occupies today. As Distributor Sales Manager for Abbott Interfast Fred's still focusses on selling our USA manufactured MS Nuts. Fred was instrumental in growing and maintaining The Nationwide Fastener Directory.

When Jim was 10, on Saturdays he would go with his dad who would work the machine shop at Continental Screw Machine. He learned the ins and out of manufacturing screw machine parts. By the time he hit high school he was working summers in the shop and eventually started full time as an operator. In 1958 Martin Binder bought the company from his dad and in 1979 the company was moved with Abbott Interfast under one roof in Wheeling, Il.. Today Jim is Vice President of Abbott Metal Werks, one of Abbotts manufacturing divisions. With the manufacturing machine world constantly changing, Jim was instrumental in helping Abbott break into modern manufacturing with the purchase of CNC machines.

### IFE 2019 Fastener Professional Award Winners Announced

LAS VEGAS, NV – August X, 2019 – International Fastener Expo (IFE) has announced the recipients of the 2019 Hall of Fame and Young Fastener Professional of the Year Awards, which annually honor professionals who have made significant contributions to the fastener industry during the annual awards ceremony at IFE, Sept. 17-19 at the Mandalay Bay Convention Center, Bayside D & E, in Las Vegas, Nev.

Ed McIlhon, Assembled Products, Inc. (API), and Martin "Marty" Nolan, R.L. English Co., were inducted into the 2019 Hall of Fame, and Baron Yarborough, Spring Bolt and Nut Manufacturing, was selected as the 2019 Young Fastener Professional of the Year. The Hall of Fame and Young Fastener Professional of the Year Awards recognize those who have made lasting inputs to the fastener industry on a national or global scale, and leaders, 40 years old or younger, who already have an unimpeachable record of integrity and respect in the industry, respectively.

McIlhon got his start in the industry at his father's Iowa Industrial Products (IIP), where he served as president, developing IIP into a \$60 million company in 1998. IIP was sold to Bossard International in 1999, and McIlhon served as president until 2005 when he purchased their kitting and bundling unit and created API, a key supplier to John Deere. McIlhon has played an integral role in negotiating the Fastener Quality Act, serving as co-chairman of the Public Law Task Force and testifying before Congress on behalf of the industry.

Nolan has been a manufacturer's representative with R.L. English Co. in Cleveland, Ohio for 34 years. He is currently the vice president of the North Coast Fastener Association (NCFA), previously serving as president for four years where he was instrumental in the development of many initiatives, including the NCFA annual Distributor Social. He also served as chairman on the Fastener Industry Coalition (FIC), and has tirelessly promoted the fas-

tener industry through www.fastenerblog. net and social media.

Yarborough is a third-generation fastener professional holding a BBA degree in management from Texas Wesleyan University. In 2014, Yarborough started a hands-on training program at Spring Bolt and Nut Manufacturing, and currently is director of sales where he leads the sales force, new business development, and marketing functions. He remains active as chairman of the Young Fastener Professionals, previously serving as president, and as a member of the Board of Directors at the Southwestern Fastener Association.

The awards are administered by the FIC, and award recipients will be honored with a commemorative plaque at the IFE Awards Ceremony on Wednesday, Sept. 18 at the Sessions Corner on the show floor. For more information on the award winners and IFE, visit www.fastenershows.com.




